
FLY-DRIVE TOUR - PICTON TO QUEENSTOWN





Bisected by the mountainous peaks of the Southern Alps, New Zealand's South Island plays host to some of the finest natural landscapes you'll find anywhere on the planet.



### Days 1–2 Nelson (134 kms)

On arrival in Picton (port or airport) you'll collect your rental car and drive to Nelson.

One of the country's sunniest spots and home to some of New Zealand's finest artists, this region is also known for its spectacular, natural landscapes including the jaw-dropping Abel Tasman National Park.

### Days 3–4 Marlborough Sounds (115 kms)

The Marlborough region is home to the beautiful Sounds, award winning wineries that you can explore by bicycle and numerous walking and hiking trails, including the Queen Charlotte Track.

#### Day 5 Kaikoura (128 kms)

From Blenheim you'll follow State Highway 1 along the coast to Kaikoura for unforgettable marine experiences. We've included a whale-watching trip but you can also take to the air for a birds-eye view.

### Day 6 Christchurch (181 kms)

This vibrant and energetic city is home to wonderful street art, cool café culture and state of the art architecture. Take time to explore the innovative regeneration.

Day 7 Aoraki-Mount Cook (285 kms)

The Aoraki Mount Cook National Park is home to New Zealand's highest mountains, longest glaciers and much of it sits within the country's only dark sky reserve. The drive from Christchurch takes you via Lake Tekapo and the Church of the Good Shepherd.



### Days 8–10 Queenstown

Wind your way through the magnificent Lindis Pass towards Queenstown. The drive takes you through the vineyards of the Otago and past historic Arrowtown, which is well-worth a visit. Your time in Queenstown is free but high on our list of recommendations would be a visit to Doubtful Sound, a 4WD tour through Middle-earth, lunch and wine-tasting at one of the award-wining Central Otago wineries and a jet boat and kayak safari on the Dart River.
