OVERVIEW

STONEBOUND CRYSTAL resin bound surfacing is a cold applied clear polyurethane resin screed designed to bind natural aggregates. STONEBOUND CRYSTAL is flexible, resistant to cracking and can be supplied in a range of colours allowing imaginative designs to be incorporated within the paved surface.

PREPARATION OF SURFACE

Concrete surfaces to be treated should be clean, dry and free of laitance, oil, grease and loose friable particles which could affect adhesion. Asphalt surfaces must be clean and dry, details of suggested suitable base build ups are available on request. A suitable edging detail should be specified using either brick, stone, concrete or steel as required to provide a high quality finish detail.

MIXING & APPLICATION

The STONEBOUND CRYSTAL Resin Part 'A' & 'B' is delivered in pre-weighed units to which the Stonebound Crystal Catalyst Part 'C' should be added (refer to Stonebound Crystal Catalyst guidance table found on provided "Mix Details" sheet with each order). To prevent an area being installed without catalyst a small quantity has already been added to Part 'A' to ensure the mixed material will cure albeit at a slower rate. Stonebound Crystal Catalyst can be added to your order in a 250ml unit. The mixed resin should then be thoroughly mixed with a slow speed, high torque drill and paddle for a minimum of 45 seconds.

The mixed STONEBOUND CRYSTAL resin should then be immediately added to the pre-mixed aggregate placed in a suitable forced action mixer. Mix for 1-2 minutes then discharge into a wheelbarrow and move immediately to the point of application.

The mixed material should then be spread evenly across the surface at the required depth using a 24" screed box or aluminium/wooden spazzle. The surface should then be hand trowelled or using a lightly weighted finishing power tool finished to a smooth compacted surface as required.

To improve the slip resistance on the surface fine anti-slip crushed glass should be applied at a rate of 50-80g per sqm. This can be added to your order in 2.5kg bags ~ $31m^2$ coverage.
