Day 12 Great Ocean Road

Cross the state border into Victoria towards the Shipwreck Coast. Visit Port Fairy before calling into the Tower Hill Reserve, where hopefully you'll get to see emu's, koalas, kangaroos and echidnas. The Great Ocean Road starts with the impressive stacks of Bay of Martyrs and Bay of Islands, and you'll also visit London Bridge and Loch Ard Gorge. At the Twelve Apostles there's opportunity to take a scenic helicopter flight (own expense) over the coastline.

Day 13 Melbourne

After breakfast visit the Otway National Park and follow the easy trail through cool, temperate rainforest past trees and ferns dating back millions of years. Then it's on to Kennett River for the chance to spot koalas, there are plenty of photo stops along the way. The afternoon is spent following the surf coast to Geelong before arriving in Melbourne late afternoon.
