

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Day 1 Sydney

After your flight to Sydney you'll be met and transferred to your hotel.

There are a multitude of ways to explore Sydney. Take to the air by seaplane for a birds-eye view of the city and harbour, or travel like a local and hop on one of the gold and green ferries that ply their way across the harbour. For guided experiences there are walks uncovering Sydney's Aboriginal past, and cycle tours that will get you away from the masses.

Day 2 Port Stephens (286 kms)

Collect your rental car and head north via the Central Coast to Port Stephens. Head out on the water to spot the resident pod of dolphins or to the largest moving sand dunes in the Southern Hemisphere for land-based adventures.

Accommodation: Bannisters Port Stephens (4 Star Hotel)

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Days 3–4 The Hunter Valley (102 kms)

A short drive inland brings you to the Hunter Valley, one of Australia's oldest wine regions. Tour the vineyards and sample the produce at cellar doors, float above the vines in a hot air balloon, rent a bicycle or explore using the hop on hop off bus that trundles around the wineries.

Accommodation: Spicers Guest House (4.5 Star Hotel)

Meal(s) Included: Breakfast

Days 5–6 Blue Mountains (243 kms)

Exchange the patchwork of gently rolling hills for the eucalyptus scented wilderness of the Blue Mountains. Head to Echo Point and view the famous Three Sisters rock formation, board the world's steepest passenger railway or cross the dramatic gorges on a glass-floored cable car.

Accommodation: Old Leura Dairy (4 Star Hotel)

Day 7 Departure

Today your tour comes to an end as you return to Sydney.
