Days 4–5 Wilsons Promontory (201 kms)

From the Mornington Peninsula head for Victoria's largest coastal wilderness area — Wilsons Promontory National Park. This 50,000-hectare reserve is laced with a labyrinth of walking trails, abundant wildlife and remote, deserted beaches. One of the Prom's newest attractions is a 2½-hour Wilderness Cruise that takes in the rugged granite coastline and raw wilderness including Skull Rock and the prehistoric boulders of Mount Oberon.

Accommodation: Limosa Rise (4 Star Hotel)

Day 6 Departure / Melbourne (213 kms)

Today your tour comes to an end. Return to Melbourne or head out along the Great Southern Touring Route towards Sydney.
