
Days 2–3 Dunedin (362 kms)

Dunedin wears its Scottish heritage with pride and you'll find an incredible line up of wildlife on its doorstep including the only place in the world where you can view Northern Royal Albatross in their natural habitat, from the mainland.

Day 4 Catlins (161 kms)


Day 5 Te Anau (205 kms)

Day 6 Doubtful Sound

You'll depart for your overnight Doubtful Sound cruise from Manapouri, just a short drive from Te Anau. After a short cruise across Lake Manapouri you'll cross the Wilmott Pass by road to Deep Cove where you'll join the Fiordland Navigator. Designed along the lines of a traditional scow, your vessel offers old world charm with spacious viewing decks, observation lounge and a fully licenced restaurant. This cruise takes in some of Fiordland's most spectacular scenery and there's opportunity to explore by kayak or tender. Accommodation is in private cabins with ensuite bathrooms.

Days 7–9 Wanaka (226 kms)
