Spectacular Game Shooting in the Weald of Kent

The Glassenbury Shoot

The current Shoot comprises two principal beats, the Goudhurst (Glassenbury) beat and the Hawkhurst (Bedgebury) beat.

The Glassenbury beat forms part of an estate which has been in the ownership of the Roberts family since the 13th century.

Set in the spectacular Weald of Kent the estate covers approximately 5,000 acres. Its historic broad leaf woodland, conifer forests and hidden valleys provide ideal terrain for showing challenging birds.

Glassenbury offers driven pheasant shooting of the highest quality and spectacular driven mallard. With over 30 pheasant drives of varying difficulty the estate caters equally for the experienced shot, the novice and corporate parties.





Facilities & Additional Services

Guns meet on the morning of a shoot at the Shoot Lodge at Triggs Farm. We normally provide tea, coffee and bacon rolls, but a full English breakfast can be provided by prior arrangement. The Shoot Manager or Shoot Captain will give a briefing on the day's sport.

Sympathetically converted from 17th century farm buildings but with all modern amenities, the Lodge provides a comfortable place to have lunch and also to relax at the end of the day.

Transport is provided for all the guns in the estate's shoot bus. If clients need to drive their own 4x4 vehicles around the shoot, this can be arranged but due to ground conditions and the need to respect the tenant farmers we prefer all clients to use the transport provided.

Included within the cost of a day's shooting are breakfast, drinks, mid-morning soup and sausages, lunch, all wine and afternoon tea.
