Delivered new to a doctor in Arcadia California in 1961 this beautiful example is one of just a small number of left-hand drive examples completed in the launch year.

A full restoration has been completed by a serial Concours-winning specialist, bringing this E-Type up to a truly 'world-class' level. The quality is immediately clear and has been proven with two 'First in Class' Concours wins and an overall second place.

The odometer reading of just 3,021 miles is likely to be the total mileage since the restoration.

Presented in the classic 1960s colours of red with biscuit trim and a black hood, this Roadster epitomises the classic image of E-Type motoring.

A comprehensive folder details the restoration and also the Concours history, with the JDHT certification confirming that the chassis, engine and body are all matching numbers.

With launch-year, flat floor cars considered to be the six-cylinder E-Type of choice, this offers opportunity for both investment and enjoyment.
