SAMPLE ACCOMMODATION

With purpose-built school group accommodation available close to the D-Day Landing beaches, the History tour to Normandy is an attractive option for school trip organisers.



UNCMT, LA BAMBINIERE

Perfectly located close to Arromanches and the beach, this centre offers school groups an on-site dining hall, classrooms, games room, teachers' lounge, TV room as well as an outdoor area featuring a roller-skating rink, volleyball court, and basketball.

All bedrooms have private bathrooms with students mainly in 6-bedded and teachers accommodated in single or twin rooms. Breakfast and evening meals are provided in the onsite restaurant with the option of booking packed lunches.

UNCMT, BERNIERES SUR MER

Located just 400 metres from Juno Beach, this centre offers school groups a dining room, classroom, TV room with wi-fi and table tennis, volleyball and basketball court.
