



A school geography field trip to Sorrento and the Amalfi Coast presents the perfect opportunity for geographical studies including plate tectonics, natural hazards, coastal and tourism management.

Visit Mount Vesuvius National Park to study the volcanic landscape, then take a trip to the archaeological site of Pompeii to understand the devastation of lava and pyroclastic flows.

Tourism is also vitally important to the region and Sorrento is a perfect example of an Italian tourist resort.

### SAMPLE ACCOMMODATION
