



SPRING FLOWERS

EXPLORING CRETE



In search of the Cretan tulip Anna Pavord had a mission to find a tulip unique to the island of Crete.

It took more than an hour, but I got to the snow. I also caught up with the rump of one of Pure Crete's specialist groups, on a week's wildlife and photography tour, led by Stephen Waters, a botanist and Clive Daws, an ecologist. We found crocus in the melting snow and, even higher, flat rock-hugging mats of an alpine anchusa, the flowers dazzling blue among the leaves. At the top, I threw a snowball at an eagle before beginning a rapid descent. And there, in an area mercifully fenced off from grazing animals, we had found the tulips. Hundreds of them. They were growing in thin, poor grassland on some abandoned terraces. Their shiny leaves poked out from sheaves of anemones, with orchids thrown in for good measure. There were also some stunning flowers, pale green and black, which I thought were dwarf iris, but which turned out to be Hermodactylus tuberosus.

For an hour or more we wandered among the flowers, leapfrogging from one small bare patch of earth to the next. There was nothing I could find to say. This was the first time I had seen tulips growing in the wild. I knew how Galahad must have felt when he finally caught up with the Grail.

Where the wild flowers grow

The houses that Pure Crete uses belong to local people. Ours sat at the top of the hill just outside the village with a terrace at the back looking out over a tangle of poppies and fennel, phlomis and sage. The food was the best I have ever had in Greece. Not a sign of moussaka or souvlaki. Instead there was lamb with lettuce in an egg and lemon sauce, black-eyed beans with fennel, salt codfish in filo pastry. CRETAN EASTER 19 April 2020





Greek Easter in Crete is more than flower-covered churches, Easter biscuits and eggs dyed red to symbolise the blood of Christ. It is a rich pageant which culminates in a candle-lit procession and the burning of Judas outside each orthodox church. Easter Sunday on 19th April is celebrated with a feast of lamb cooked over open fires with local village wine at the local taverna compliments of Pure Crete.

Country Walking in Crete

A week starting 1 May or 6 October 2020

For 2020 we are pleased to include two new walks on our popular walking holiday, with the expert guidance of Sophia Chapman, our Greek-English guide for 2020 Pure Crete walking holidays. Five days of leisurely to medium paced walks of about 6 to 7 miles in the rolling countryside and dramatic gorges of Western Crete visiting villages and ancient sites amidst the abundance of Spring flowers with a backdrop of snow-capped mountains. Walks are 3 to 4 hours ending in lunch at a village taverna to sample local Cretan cuisine.

Walks take in the hills and the valleys of Western Crete as well as traditional villages and quiet ancient sites which are particularly beautiful in the Spring and Autumn with the abundance of wild flowers and plants. New walks for 2020 include Stylos – Machairi – Neo Chorio and Azogires (near Paleochora) to Anidri and down the Anidri gorge, as well as our old favourites of Nippos/ Vafes, Polyrinnia/ Sirikari Gorge and Argiroupolis.

The tour is suitable for single travellers as well as couples and small groups. Spaces are limited to 14 so early booking is advised. The per person price of £995 includes your flight and a week of Pure Crete accommodation in Aptera. Transfers included.



(HANIA

The principal town of the area is Chania, a Venetian port whose attractive and lively harbour provides the perfect setting for an evening stroll before dinner at one of the many waterfront tavernas. Behind the harbour a maze of narrow back streets links a mixture of old Venetian and Turkish houses often stunningly decorated with hanging flowers. Five minutes walk away is Chania's covered market, well known for the wide variety of fresh produce on offer. Nearby, local handicraft shops provide a good place to find handmade leather goods, rugs and lace.

APTERA (MEGALA (HORAFIA)

7 1/2 miles along the coast from Chania, the road winds gently up to Aptera (formerly Megala Chorafia) a Cretan village set in the foothills of the White Mountains.

The village's hilltop setting makes for breathtaking panoramic views, over Souda Bay to the North and of the White Mountains, rising over 7,000ft, to the South.

Megala Chorafia, which literally means "Big Fields", is a scatter of houses and farms with an ornate orthodox church as its centrepiece. The 'Metoche' area on the Eastern side is on a ridge which extends towards the ancient ruins of Aptera. Wild flowers bloom along narrow roads on which shepherds move their flocks between fields. There are three tavernas in the village, a cafeneion and a small 'pantopoleion' or minimarket. The archaeological remains of Aptera, dating from the Minoan and Roman times, are within walking distance of the village. Beyond these stands a Turkish castle, perched strategically on the headland overlooking the sea.

A daily bus service links the village to Chania, but we would strongly recommend car hire to enjoy your stay to the full.

Nearby sandy beaches include the blue beach, Kalami (2 1/2 miles), where a mountain river meets the sea to provide a refreshingly cool dip; Kalives (3 miles, photo page 16) whose beachside tavernas serve freshly caught fish. All are uncrowded. Further afield beach lovers will appreciate the 6 miles of white sand which stretches from Georgioupolis (15 miles) to Paradise Beach. SCULPTOR'S HOUSE

Commanding breathtaking views over Souda Bay this house offers a comfortable,romantic dwelling with some of the sculptor's original works. It shares a large pool with the Cottage, with a short diving board and shallow end.

- Restored stone building with northerly facing windows
- Spacious living room with soft seats, table and chairs, kitchen facilities and a single bed
- Living room leads through a large Cretan archway to air conditioned double bedroom which may be closed off completely by a curtain
- Bathroom off bedroom with shower. Solar panel.

It is within walking distance (3/4 mile) of a choice of good tavernas and village store and is 5 minutes drive to sandy beaches.

SCULPTOR'S COTTAGE

Offering impressive views across Souda Bay one way and towards the White Mountains the other, this stone built cottage is full of romantic charm accentuated by the sculptor's artefacts that adorn it. It shares the large pool with the House.

- Enter the cottage into the dining area with table & chairs and kitchen facilities. Bathroom with shower
- Cottage is divided by a stone Cretan archway leading to seating area with sofa and traditional fireplace. Double bed. An additional single bed is available on balcony above, accessed by steep wooden stairs.
- Air conditioning. Solar panel.

Aptera tavernas & village store 3/4 mile and sandy beach about 4 miles. Pool is 6m x 4.5m, depth 1 - 1.5m (child section 0.4m)

ARTEMIS

Artemis' House is a traditional stone-built house that offers a romantic hideaway with spectacular mountain views. After many years standing empty it has been restored with loving care and traditional methods to provide a comfortable and charming retreat looking over the village and up to the White Mountains. Its large veranda has a low wall and a mature mulberry tree which provides

mulberry tree which provides ample shade at this lovely villa.

- Fully fitted kitchen with original features
- Bathroom with shower including bread oven
- Double bedroom with air con
- Living room with Cretan archway; sofabed
- Solar panel.

The taverna and village shop is about 1/2 mile and the nearest beaches about 41/2 miles.

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METOCHE PENTHOUSE

has breathtaking sea views over Souda Bay and is within five minutes drive of the secluded beaches. External stone steps from the pretty courtyard lead via the first terrace to the Penthouse with its marble floors, thick stone walls and beamed ceilings keeping it cool through the summer.

- Roof terrace with southerly views across the village to the White Mountains
- Large private second terrace with sunloungers provides northerly panoramic views across Souda Bay, ideal for eating 'al fresco'
- Two twin bedrooms with ceiling fans. Bathroom with shower. Air con in main bedroom.

BOTONAKIS FAMILY HOUSE

Offering panoramic views across Souda Bay, the Metoche Botonakis Family House is just five minutes drive to the secluded beaches. The private terrace behind the house has sun loungers and table & chairs to eat 'al fresco' and admire the view.

- Ground floor: large living/dining room with sofa and traditional corner fireplace with log burning stove, dining table and chairs with marble floors and beamed ceilings throughout. Sliding patio doors onto the private terrace, offering panoramic sea views, table and chairs to eat "al fresco" and sun loungers for sunbathing. Newly installed ground floor bathroom with shower cubicle and w.c.
 - Stone Cretan Archway to fully fitted kitchen with electric cooker, fridge etc. WIFI
- First floor: spacious lounge with marble floors and panoramic views from the balcony. Double & twin bedrooms with celing fans. Family bathroom has a shower & bath. Air con in twin bedroom.

APTERA

Villa Manos is a stone built traditional villa on one level with a large pool (8x5m). It is divided into two semi-detached village houses each with sea and mountain views. There is a spacious garden and each house has its own terrace, staggered for privacy, with comfortable seating.

- Each house is comfortable with sofas, a fireplace, dining table & chairs and air conditioning and wifi
- Furnished to high standards in traditional style with tiled floors & wooden ceilings

A peaceful red-roofed stone-built house with glorious views over rolling countryside. A charming hideaway, this old village house has a large courtyard with natural shade from which to enjoy the views of the White Mountains.

- Sitting room with sofa; bathroom with shower
- Double bedroom and separate entrance from courtyard
- Twin bedroom accessed via double bedroom
- Large courtyard with countryside and Mountain views and carob tree for shade. This Cretan village cottage has a step at the entrance, one to the bathroom and three steps down to bedrooms.

MARIALENA VILLAS

Marialena villas are set in rolling countryside in the beautiful hill top village of Aptera with the stunning backdrop of the white mountains. The five one and two bedroom villas are set in a pretty garden area, each with their own separate entrance and beautiful large veranda to admire the views. The shared spacious pool is child free (2nd child friendly pool available).

- One bedroom villas: double or twin bedroom, living room with sofa bed, kitchen corner with fridge freezer, full cooker & coffee maker, bathroom with shower

APTERA ANNA APARTMENTS

Aptera Apartments stand on the hill in the village of Aptera, with breath taking, panoramic sea views across Souda Bay. All rooms have large verandas with sea view, fully equipped kitchen, spacious living room with sofas and a dining room, bathroom with shower. There is air conditioning in all rooms, a TV and free WIFI. Aptera has a large swimming pool and a children's pool. The beautiful garden with lush greenery and the palm trees offer cool shade to the guests who can enjoy the view while lying on the sun beds under the umbrellas. Aptera Apartments consist of two studios for up to 2 people, four one bedroomed apartments with living room for up to 3 people and four two bedroomed apartments with a spacious living room for up to 5 people.

A choice of tavernas and a village shop in Aptera (Megala Chorafia) are within walking distance (3/4 mile) and the sandy beaches of Kalami and Kalives are just a 5 to 7 minute drive away.



Set within glorious countryside framed by the White Mountains is Neo Chorio, a quiet, sleepy village of just 600 inhabitants on the old road between Chania and Rethymnon, Centuries of history ooze from its stone buildings. It was mentioned by Edward Lear in his 1865 Cretan Journal and today remains a charming retreat amidst rural tranquillity.

VILLA CHRYSSA

Villa Chryssa is a traditional stone-built Cretan house with a private pool. It rests in the valley of the village amongst the olive groves, with breath-taking mountain views, and is just 300 metres from the village centre with its cafes, taverna and village shop.

It is an ideal retreat for couples and families alike. It is modernly-equipped and comfortably furnished:-

Downstairs:-

Comfortable living room, with sofas and fireplace, leading through Cretan archway into dining area and to fully equipped kitchen. Bathroom with shower.

Upstairs:-

Two bedrooms, one with double bed and ensuite bathroom with bath and showerover-the-bath and one twin room. Large balcony with panoramic mountain and village views.

It is less than a mile from Armeni Village tavernas and shops and two miles (5-10 minutes' drive) to the sandy beaches of Kalives with its tavernas and shops. Chania is a half hour drive. The owners Chryssa and Panayiotis live nearby with their family in the village.

STILOS - VILLA DIKTAMOS

Villa Dictamos is less than ten minutes drive from the sandy beaches of Kalives and stands alone at the head of the Dictamo Gorge outside the village of Stilos.

This impressive family house with private pool stands in a dramatic landscape of mountains and olive groves, farmland and vineyards which provide a rural tranquility only occasionally broken by

birdsong and distant sheep bells. The house is traditionally built to a high standard and equipped with modern comforts. This comfortable and spacious villa has surrounding terraces, grassed lawns and matured gardens, with stunning views over countryside towards the mountains. The house offers a variety of choices for relaxing and dining in the shade or sun from its covered terraces and areas around the villa plus a separate barbecue and dining area.

- Ground floor: open-plan sitting room, dining area and kitchen, with dishwasher, leading to covered terrace; twin bedroom leading to terrace; bathroom with bath and shower
- First floor: one double bedroom leading to covered terrace; twin bedroom leading to covered terrace; bathroom with bath and shower

Three minutes drive to Stilos, famous for it's natural springs, with a choice of four tavernas and two minimarkets. Walkers will appreciate the Dictamo Gorge.

CARLA'S HOUSE

Carla's is a three bedroomed, comfortable Cretan house near the village of Tsivaras a few minutes' drive from the sandy beaches of Kalives and Almirida. Its large swimming pool and secluded garden offer countryside views. Newly refurbished. Fully fitted kitchen, dining room and living room divided by traditional Cretan archways. Comfortable sitting area with sofa and fireplace, TV with & DVD/CD player. Bathroom with shower. Washing machine



- Upstairs double bedroom, twin bedroom & second bathroom (with shower). Large roof terrace with countryside views
- Self-contained 'guest wing' comprising third bedroom, shower room simply fitted and small living room

STEPHANOS HOUSE

Armeni is a sleepy Cretan village set in a green valley of orange groves, just over a mile inland from the coast at Kalives.

In the village there is a church, tavernas, cafenions, a mini market, bakery and a butchers with a cheese deli.

Some ten minutes walk (1/4 mile) from the village centre on the level road towards Kalives are two small Cretan cottages, Stephanos and Iliana's, each overlooking the lush green river valley. Both



houses have a spacious terrace as well as a roof terrace with sun loungers and countryside views.

Stephanos has a small living room with kitchen corner, a separate double bedroom with air con and a bathroom with shower. The terrace with tables and chairs is available for eating 'al fresco' and a roof terrace ideal for sunbathing, admiring the countryside views and star gazing in the evening.

Kalives is about one mile away and has tavernas and shops as well as long stretches of sandy beach

- Within easy reach of Kalives Beach
- Countryside views
- Armeni village has tavernas, cafe bakery, store and deli/cheese shop

ALL QUIET ON WESTERN FRONT by Richard Morrison



The Turkish Fort at Aptera

Over in the west, in the rolling, rural foothills between the ancient port of Chania and the glorious White Mountains, is a Crete that seems frozen in time, along with its unpretentious tavernas, its farming villages, its gorgeous orange groves, its twisting mountain roads, and its secret gorges. To be a tourist here almost seems a crime; you feel that you might somehow dislodge the delicate workings of a society that gives off an aura of absolute tranquillity.

But if you are going to be a tourist, do what we did. Rent a marvellous old farmhouse. We went to an Anglo-Cretan company, Pure Crete, that specialises in using local craftsmen and materials to restore old properties. Our walls were a yard thick; great stone slabs paved the floor; archways and huge urns proclaimed our Grecian surroundings as clearly as the words that drifted up from the people harvesting avocados just below our balcony. Then eat and more importantly, drink - in the local tavernas, where the hospitality flows as freely as olive oil over the feta salad. Walk the lanes which, in late spring, are fringed by as colourful a carpet of wild flowers as anywhere in Europe.

And scramble to the top of one of the great Venetian or Turkish coastal forts - the spectacular Aptera, overlooking the deep blue Bay of Souda, was just a mile or two from where we lived – and watch the sun set on essentially the same scene as the voyaging Ulysses might have enjoyed three millennia ago. Even if you confine yourself to this relatively uncrowded western part of Crete, the contrasts are remarkable.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

1. Booking Procedure - Provisional bookings should be made by telephone to ensure that the accommodation and aircraft seats are available for the dates required. Such bookings will be held for three working days pending the receipt of a completed booking form and the deposit of £250 per person and £70 per hire car week. A higher deposit may be required dependent on your flight carrier, this will be discussed at the time your holiday is reserved. The booking will then be confirmed in writing and a confirmation invoice issued showing the balance due. This must be paid in full not less than 12 weeks before departure. For our privacy policy & how we handle your data please refer to our website.

2. Changes by you – If you change your booking after the confirmation invoice has been issued (eg name/date change) this must be received in writing & we will charge you £40 per alteration (or £80 within 4 weeks of departure) plus any charges made by the Company's Suppliers (e.g the cost of a new airline ticket if amendment/cancellation fees apply). If your changes are not possible or there is a change of date then the original booking will have to be cancelled & the cancellation charges in paragraph 4 applied. ** Please note on some airlines, date changes are not permitted and your flight will have to be cancelled at 100% cancellation charges. Name change charges are subject to your airline's terms and conditions and you will be advised of the amount at the time your booking is amended.**

3. Material Alteration - In the unlikely event of Pure Crete having to make a material alteration to your holiday, you will be advised of the change as soon as is reasonably possible. The company reserves the right in any circumstances to alter or cancel a flight. A material alteration is considered to be a change in airport, resort area, change of flight times by more than 12 hours. Should a material alteration or cancellation become necessary, you will have the choice of (a) Accepting the alternative arrangements (b) Choosing another available holiday from our programme or (c) Cancelling with a full refund. Should you accept any of these alternatives, no other claims for compensation or expenses will be considered unless we notify you of material alterations /cancellations within 8 weeks of departure. In this case, we will pay compensation of £10 per person. No compensation or claims will be considered in the event of alteration / cancellation due to force majeure events. (see condition 9).

4. Cancellation – In the event of a cancellation Pure Crete must be notified in writing and the following cancellation charges will apply from the time your written instructions are received by us:

6. Prices – Prices are based upon known fuel costs, exchange rates and taxes. Surcharges may become applicable due to currency fluctuations, general increase in aviation fuel costs, government levies & taxes, security charges and insurance costs. Any such surcharges may be passed on directly to our clients without profit to Pure Crete.

7. Accommodation – Description and Use – Pure Crete makes every effort to ensure that descriptions of accommodation and amenities are accurate but it shall not be liable in the event that any aspect of the holiday fails for reasons outside Pure Crete's control. The accommodation is only for the use of the passengers shown on the booking form. Sub-letting, assignment, or sharing is prohibited. Clients are responsible for leaving their accommodation in same condition as at the start of their holiday. Any breakages should be reported to our representative and paid for. The client is liable for charges incurred from damage or abuse of property overseas.

8. Liability – Pure Crete shall not be liable for any loss or damage arising in connection with a holiday caused by any matter outside the reasonable control of Pure Crete. This includes, but is not limited to, Acts of God, civil disturbance, strikes or industrial action, acts of government, failure of public supplies (e.g. water or electricity), failure of local transport to convey clients to their departure/destination airports, failure of mechanical equipment e.g. air conditioning and boilers. However Pure Crete will make all reasonable efforts to remedy such equipment failures. The conditions imposed by all carriers shall be deemed to be accepted by the client and are available on request. Contracts for excursions purchased locally in resort are between the consumer and the excursion provider, the tour operator acts as the agent and will not be liable for the excursion.

9. Complaints – In the unlikely event of a complaint please notify us in writing no later than 28 days after the completion of your holiday. No complaints will be considered after this time. "If you have a dispute with your tour operator which you are unable to resolve, you may call upon the low-cost AITO Independent Dispute Settlement Service (details on request). Claims which exceed £2,500 per person or £10,000 per

booking form or claims which apply principally or exclusively in respect of (or as a consequence of) illness or physical injury are not admissible for settlement under the service." In addition, Pure Crete must be notified of any complaints whilst you are in Greece so that we can assist in resolving any issues whilst in resort.

10. Consumer Protection, ATOL & TOPP – The air holidays and flights in this brochure are ATOL Protected, since we hold an Air Travel Organiser's Licence granted by the Civil Aviation Authority. Our ATOL number is ATOL 5889. 


