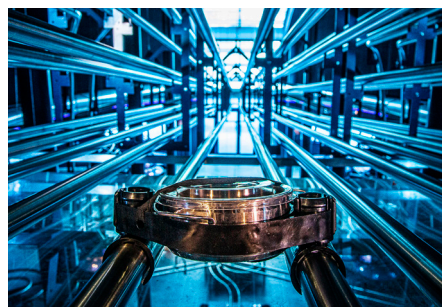
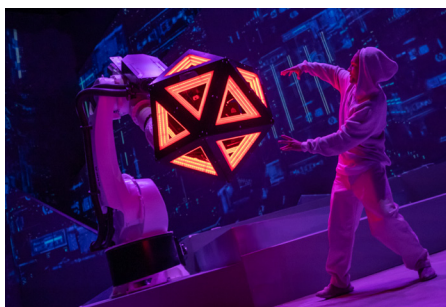
School groups receive free study guides in advance of their visit covering the “Dances with Robots” and “Cosmic Collisions” attractions.
