RESORT INFORMATION

Mont Sainte Anne sits between 174 and 800 metres above sea level, offering 71 slopes and vertical descents of up to 625 metres across three sides of the mountain. It is perfect for school ski groups looking to progress quickly and safely.

All equipment is stored at the mountain each night, making the start and end of each day completely hassle free. With over 4 metres of natural snowfall per season supplemented by snowmaking across the main mountain, you are guaranteed great conditions.

Beginners start on a dedicated area with a magic carpet and can progress onto a variety of trails served by a well-organised network of 9 lifts. The longest run stretches over 2.8 miles, offering plenty of space to develop skills. Groups are supported daily by the highly regarded local ski school, ensuring maximum learning in a safe and fun environment. The base lodge provides easy access to lessons, lunches, and facilities, making group management simple and efficient.
