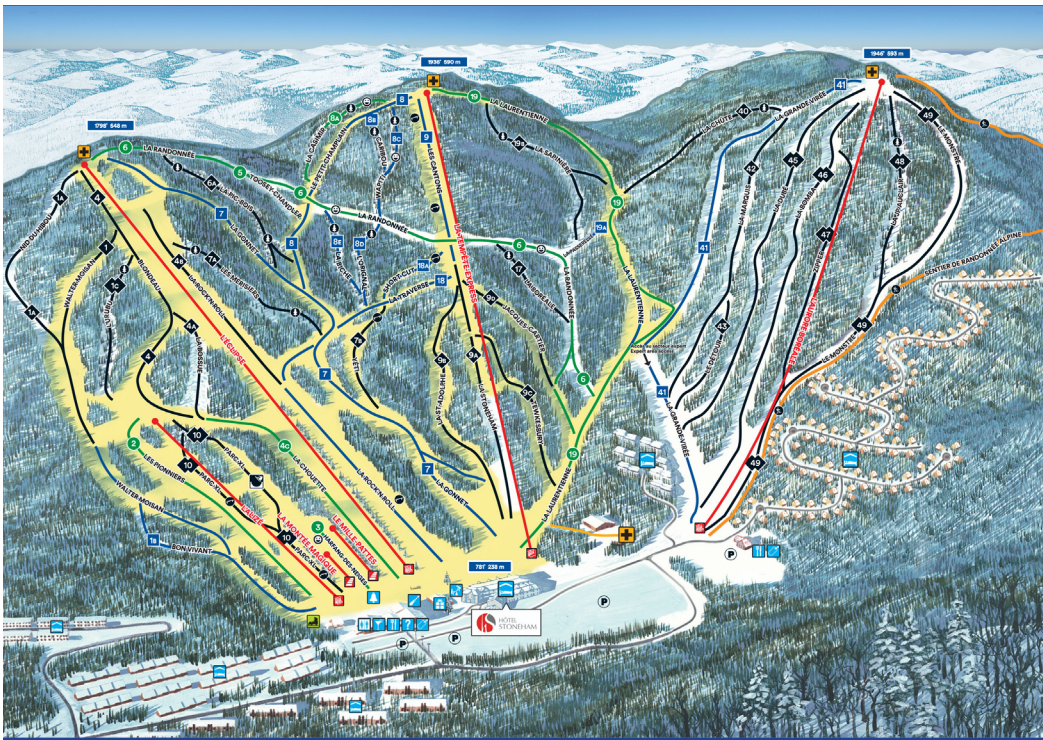

## RESORT INFORMATION

Stoneham's high-speed chair lift network, including the longest lift over 1500 metres, provides quick and easy access to the entire three-mountain domain. The resort's wooded slopes cater to all abilities, making it perfect for school groups.

The purpose-built layout ensures easy group management, with all skiing starting and ending at the base lodge, which houses ski hire, storage, shops, a cafeteria, and other essential services. Beginners have direct access to gentle slopes and the magic carpet, while more advanced skiers can explore the mountains via the chair lifts.

A highly regarded in-resort ski school ensures students progress safely while having fun, making every lesson both productive and enjoyable.

- Conservez la maîtrise de votre vitesse et de votre direction. Assurez-vous d'être en mesure d'arrêter et d'éviter toute personne ou obstacle.

**CODE ADOPTED UNDER THE ACT RESPECTING SAFETY IN SPORTS. THIS CODE APPLIES TO ANYONE PRACTICING SNOW SPORTS.**

- Remain in control of your speed and direction. Make sure you can stop and avoid any person or obstacle.
- Yield the right of way to persons downhill and choose a course that ensures their safety.
- Stop on a trail only if you are visible from above and if you are not obstructing the trail.
- Yield the right of way to persons uphill when entering a trail and at intersections.
- If you are involved in or witness an accident, remain at the scene and identify yourself to a first-aid.
- Do not use lifts or trails if you are under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Respect all signs and warnings and never venture out of bounds or on closed trails.
- There are inherent risks in practicing ski or snowboard that you should be aware of. For a rewarding and safe experience, you must abide by the Mountain Code of Conduct and be courteous to others. You must respect all the rules and signs issued in connection with specific activities and physically delimited by the ski resort.
