



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

UK NATIONALS

EU

- We recommend you carry a letter from the School confirming the list of students and staff travelling on the school trip, with dates, destination of travel. This letter must be on headed paper from School, dated and signed by Senior Management of the School.
- We recommend you carry the consent letter from parents/guardians, giving permission for the students to attend the trip. This letter must be signed and date by one of the parents/guardians. You can keep them digitally on your mobile device.
- **ETIAS** (European Travel Information Authorisation System) for UK passengers to travel to the EU are **not yet in place**.
- **UK passport holders require a minimum of 3 months passport validity after the departure date**
- **The Passport date of issue must be less than 10 years before the date you arrive.** Please recheck the date of issue as soon as possible.

NON-UK & NON-EU NATIONALS

EU

- Parents/guardians must contact the relevant Embassy (of the country you are **travelling to**) to check if a **VISA for travel is required**.

There are some European countries which will waive the need of VISA to a student who is Resident and studying in the UK, and we recommend that the parent/guardian seek this confirmation from the relevant Embassy/ Consulate accordingly to avoid issues at the check-in/border at Airports.

- Visions in Education can provide a Visa support letter regarding the student to confirm the booking on the School trip. Please request this from your Tour Coordinator with the name of the student.
- The party leader must carry a letter from the School confirming the enrolment of the student at the School and that you are travelling on a school trip. This letter must be on headed paper from School, dated and signed by Senior Management of the School.
- The party leader must carry the consent letter from parents, giving permission for the student to attend the trip. This letter must be signed and date by one of the parents/guardians.
- Please ensure parents/guardians request visas/any entry requirements as early as as possible.
